

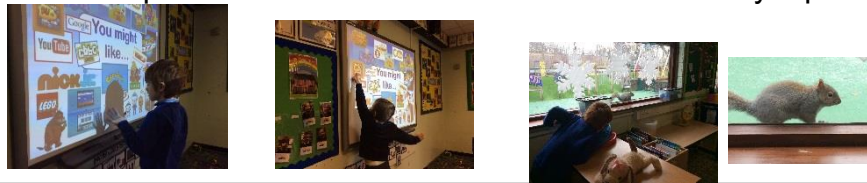
# Elm Class's Weekly News
