This Week

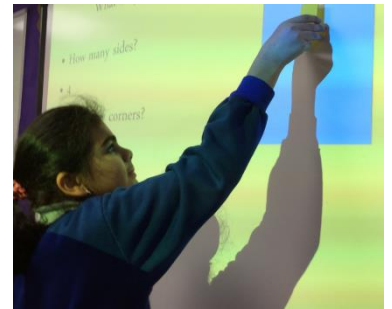
In science, we have been learning about light and reflection. We made a big periscope in the outdoor learning area - we all had a go at looking at different autumn items through it. Can you see it here on the right?
