Morning Work

Make a full range of weather symbols that you can use through the week - sun, rain, cloud, snow, wind, cold, warm, etc. Now chat about what it's like today, and stick a symbol up on a chart or your fridge. Some of you could even write, or copy-write a sentence - Today it is... and..

English

Try to think of some words with the 'ng' sound in them - you could ask a parent to give you some choices. Write them on cards and have a go at segmenting and blending the sounds, e.g. king - k i ng. Then, look at the cards randomly and see if you can read them or find them if your parent says the word. Finally, try to say the words in sentences, and perhaps write the sentences down.

Maths

Make a number line from 0 - 20. There's one here if you have a printer, but they can be easily made with a long piece of paper:

Now ask your parent to write a list of addition sentences using two numbers each, and not totaling more than 20. Use the number line to count on to add. There's an example here: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=tp9n4kMTuQo>

Perhaps you could set yourself a challenge to see how many you can do in ten minutes!

Computing

We have been working on 'algorithms' which are simple sets of instructions. Could you make a map on a piece of paper and guide a small toy figure around by giving a set of instructions? You could even write them down, e.g. Walk forward to the end of the road. Turn left...
