Morning work

Find out what you're going to have for lunch. Draw a picture and write a menu. Ask your parent to write it down for you to copy, if you need to.

Reading

On the internet, find a painting of sunflowers by Van Gogh. Could you find items around the house to make some model sunflowers? Or perhaps you could paint or draw and colour your own version.
